BOB NOTES...

Over the past several months I have given brief descriptions of each of the books of the Bible in an effort to give us basic knowledge about the main themes contained in them.

We took a break from our series last month in order to focus on Easter and the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. Now that the month of May is upon us, this month's focus is only on one book—the book of Acts.

In March we began our study of the New Testament with the four gospels. In June, we will begin looking at Paul's 13 letters (see schedule below). This month is the book which comes in-between the Gospels and the Letters and that is the Book of Acts.

Acts is sometimes referred to as the Acts of the Apostles because it centers on the acts of Christ's apostles following the time of his ascension into heaven which is described in the first chapter.

The book was written by Luke, believed by most to be the same author as the Gospel of Luke, and it is a continuation of that narrative. Luke was known as the first historian of the early years of the Church.

The book of Acts is also some-Spirit". The Holy Spirit is this one book. This book is also more of a detailed account of Church than any other place in

The Holy Spirit is referred to more than fifty times in this one book. times called "The Acts of the Holy referred to more than fifty times in of highest importance because it gives the beginning and early work of the the Bible.

Acts is the primary textbook for the study of missionary principles, the defense of the faith, the Person and work of the Holy Spirit and the methods and themes of Christian preaching.

Acts is divided into eight sections: 1. The Waiting Church 2. From Pentecost to the Conversion of Saul. 3. From the Conversion of Saul to the First Missionary Journey 4. The First Missionary Journey 5. The Council of Jerusalem 6. The Second Missionary Journey. 7. The Third Missionary Journey 8. Paul travels from Jerusalem to Rome

A movie recently in theatres entitled "Paul—Apostle of Christ" gives a dramatic rendering of the latter chapters of the book and the time Paul spent in a Roman prison at the end of his life.

I encourage each person to spend some time in the Acts in order to develop a better understanding of the background of our faith history.


