A total of fifteen Sundays. One year since we began live-streaming our worship services. First on Facebook, and later on both You Tube and Facebook.

During this year, some in our congregation have lost friends or loved ones due to COVID-19. A handful of our folks were diagnosed with COVID-19. And almost everyone in the congregation has had friends and loved ones who were diagnosed with it.

A year ago at this time, we were making plans of how to do Maundy Thursday Communion as a drive-through set up. A year ago at this time, Easter Service was being planned for an empty sanctuary. A year ago...


