TOWN HALL MEETING

ATTENTION: TOWN HALL MEETING SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 13th @ 6 pm

I have been in prayer and in conversation with many people about the deep issues which have divided so many within our denomination. Our

Administrative Council here at Rossville United Methodist Church has discussed these at varying meetings over the past year. The Council, at their September meeting, decided it was time to bring the whole congregation up to date on these matters.

Therefore, everyone connected with our church is encouraged to attend a Town Hall Meeting on Sunday evening November 13th at 6 pm. At this meeting, I as well as our Council Chairperson Ginny McCabe will present information about what has transpired in the denomination over the past few years. We will also share information which will help those who attend the meeting to come to a decision of discernment in regard to what the future holds for Rossville United Methodist Church both short term and long term. Each person needs to prayerfully consider what direction God wants us to go in. Will we continue as we have for our entire 191 year history here at Rossville? As Rossville United Methodist Church and its predecessor names (Rossville Methodist; Rossville Methodist Episcopal)? Or will God lead us into something else? Who are we? What does God want of us? Will we have much of a long-term future if we don't start attracting more folks from younger generations for that future to even exist no matter the name of our church?

Anyway, this meeting could be the first of many depending what is decided. However, this particular meeting will not include a decision on whether we will remain a United Methodist church or not. But we will take a "straw poll" towards the end of the meeting about whether we should begin a process which could lead to Rossville disaffiliating from the United Methodist Church. The results of the "straw poll" will determine our next steps which would include either a) Set up an additional town hall meeting with our superintendent Lore Blinn Gibson to answer questions which we currently don't have answers for. Or b) Decide to wait until after the United Methodist Church General Conference meets in 2024 at which time we will respond to their actions with a decision on the future of Rossville Church.

If you have any interest in how our Rossville Church will continue in the future, it is vitally important that you attend this first town hall meeting.

May our Lord Jesus Christ guide us as we look into the future. In Christ.

ALL SAINTS SUNDAY NOVEMBER 6th


